

Review of the Poorly Known Harvestman Subfamily Opilioninae (Arachnida: Opiones: Phalangiidae) with *Himalphalangium spinulatum* from Korea¹

ABSTRACT

Himalphalangium spinulatum (Roewer, 1911) collected from Gijang-gun, Busan-city, Korea is redescribed with spination of leg, detailed illustrations including SEM photographs for the first time. *Bidentolophus bidens* (Simon, 1880) as a junior synonym of *Opilio koreanus* Charitonov, 1957 from North Korean is additionally reported in the Korean fauna. These two genera are reported as new to Korea. Also, a key to the species of Korean subfamily Opilioninae is provided
